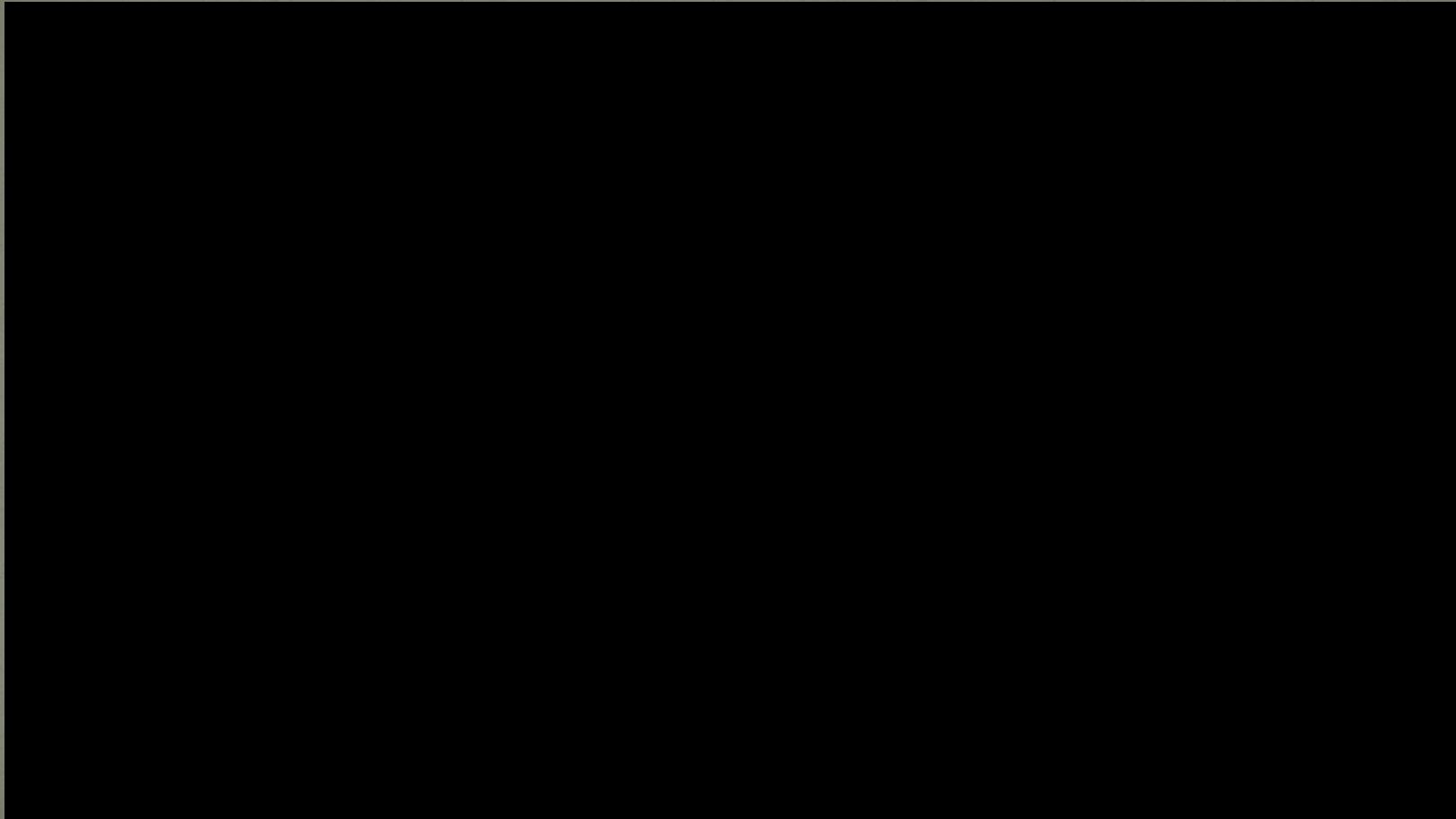


Timeline of the Sacred Scriptures

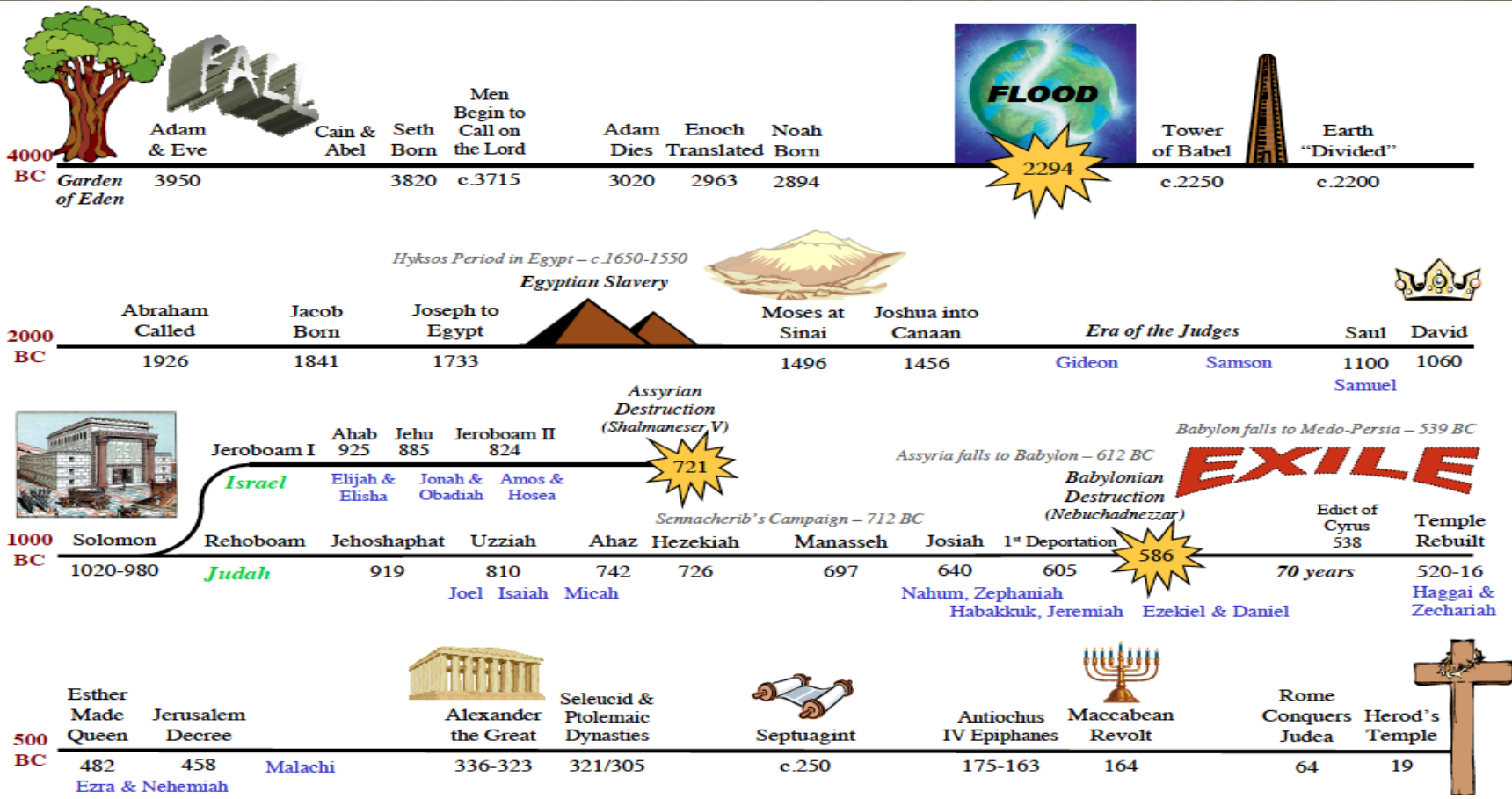
- How do the events in the Old Testament and the life of ancestors in faith pre-figure Christ's life?

The Four Sections of the Old Testament

• Law/Pentateuch

- “Penta” = Greek for “five”
- Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Deuteronomy, Numbers
- Historical
 - Ex. Joshua, Judges, 1 & 2 Samuel, 1 & 2 Kings
- Wisdom Literature
 - Psalms (Written by King David)
 - Proverbs (Written by King Solomon)
 - Job, Ecclesiastes, Wisdom, Sirach
- Prophetic Books
 - Ex. Isaiah, Jeremiah, Daniel, Jonah, Zechariah
