TRANSITIONS: word or phrase signals you are introducing evidence.

Set up the scene by briefly providing context (ie remind reader what is happening when and where)

* sticks to the facts.
* direct quote
- whole quote
- part(s) of quote

* Paraphrase can be used instead of direct quote

* Put page # and p. in parentheses @ end of sentence
* Paraphrase what happened what character did or said.
